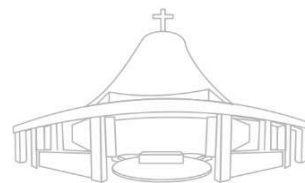

It is also available for baptized people who have not celebrated Confirmation or Eucharist, or for any Catholic church member who wants to learn more about their faith.

Rite of Christian Initiation for Children (RCIC) is an adaptation of the RCIA for children and youth. ***Registration** for RCIA & RCIC closes on **Sep 30, 2025.**
