132 AVENUE EAST COLLECTOR RENEWAL SCHOOL BULLETIN

Beginning in April 2026, 132 Avenue East starts Year 3 of Collector Renewal construction

Once complete, 132 Avenue will include one lane of traffic in each direction with a repaved road, widened sidewalks and new active transportation lanes. This ensures all Edmontonians can use 132 Avenue safely, whether they're walking, biking, rolling or driving.

The Project Team is committed to keeping community members informed during construction. Updates on construction will be posted at edmonton.ca/132Avenue. You can also sign up for email updates on the web page.

LANE CLOSURES

To accommodate construction, lane closures will be in effect starting April 20 until the end of the school year. **Two-way traffic will be maintained on 132 Avenue, with one lane of traffic in each direction.**

It's important to note, these closures will not change how you access St. Matthew Elementary School.

While access to the school is being maintained, the closures may result in additional traffic congestion in the area. It is recommended to leave extra travel time or use other options like public transportation.

At the end of June, 132 Avenue will be, temporarily, fully closed from 90 Street to just west of 82 Street.

132 Avenue from 90 Street to 86 Street is scheduled to be reopened by the end of August, before the start of the 2026/2027 school year.

BUS DETOURS

The school bus loading area (marked in pink on the map) remains in the current location in front of the school throughout construction.

During construction, a number of ETS and school special routes will be detoured around the construction site. A temporary bus stop will be available for the School Special routes on the east side of 90 Street, between 132 Avenue and 133 Avenue. ACCESS IMPACTS

To keep everyone safe during construction, the Project Team asks you to:

- Follow all signage and any site crew directions
- Drop children off from the passenger side of the vehicle
- Do not stop in driving lanes or crosswalks
- Use designated drop-off and pick-up zones, when available (identified on the map below)
- Find parking away from 132 Avenue, where possible, to assist with pick up and drop offs

The map at the bottom of this bulletin shows pick-up/drop-off zones, including specific areas for those with accessibility needs.

Pick-up and drop-off zones (marked in purple on the map) will be available at the following locations:

- On 131 A Avenue between 86 Street and 87 Street
- On 87 Street, south of 131 A Avenue
- On 131 A Avenue, between 89 Street and 88 Street

The intersection at 132 Avenue and 88 Street (marked with a yellow square) is closed April 20. To access the zones south of 132 Avenue, please use 130A Avenue off 90 Street or 131A Avenue off 86 Street, marked in orange. Please note, the intersection at 88 Street and 132 Avenue will be closed. To exit the zones west of the school, please use the alley marked in green on the map.

A zone for those with accessibility needs is shown in blue on the map. This zone is just west of the school, along 88 Street and between 132 Avenue and 131A Avenue. This zone can be accessed via 89 Street from 130A Avenue.

The area under construction starting April 20 is marked in red.
