# RCIA (Adults)/ RCIC (Age 7 or older):

Rite of Christian Initiation for Adults (RCIA) is for non-baptized people or people baptized in another Christian tradition to be welcomed into the Catholic Church. It is also available for baptized people who have not celebrated Confirmation or Eucharist, or for any Catholic church member who wants to learn more about their faith.

**Rite of Christian Initiation for Children (RCIC)** is an adaptation of the RCIA for children and youth. \*Registration for RCIA & RCIC closes on Sep 28, 2024.
